Is in her first year as the Girls Varsity Basketball Coach at Denair High. As a player Coach Garza honed her skills locally at Modesto Christian earning all-district honors. As a prep her teams went 55-13 and played for a state title as a junior. After completion of high school and a brief stop at UOP, she landed at Cal Poly. Coach Garza played for 3 years where she won the "hustle award" in the Big West Conference and played in the NCAA tourney as a junior.
